Water Conservation Workshops

Hundreds of gallons of water are wasted each year due to ineffective lawn sprinkler systems. The City of Dallas encourages residents to have an irrigation audit conducted every five years.

The Texas Agricultural Extension Service (part of the Texas A & M University System) offers a Landscape Irrigation Auditing Workshop. This

workshop is designed to help you audit your irrigation system and its efficiency.

The next scheduled workshop is scheduled for Saturday, October 27 at the North Dallas Government Center, 10056 Marsh Lane, Suite B-101 Basement. The building is located at the corner of Marsh Lane and Walnut Hill, adjacent Wendy's. The workshop

runs from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon.

To register for the workshop, call 214.904.3050. Space is limited and participants must register by September 24. If you are unable to attend this session, the extension service can waitlist you for a future class and notify you once the class becomes available.
